

# **Voice the Constitution<sup>©</sup>**

## **Read This First**

Print the document called ConstitutionCards.pdf onto 8-½ by 11 card stock. Cut each card in half yielding two 8-½ by 5-½ cards. Different printers feed differently and so we don't provide a center-of-page indicator. It works better if you measure and mark the 5 1/2 inch point after you've printed it. They are in large type for easier podium reading (although, Julian still uses his reading glasses). See FacilitatorNotes.pdf for card distribution instructions.

Print several copies of Definitions.pdf and hand them out to the people attending.

Print out FacilitatorNotes.pdf. The facilitator should read this through a few times before the reading begins.
